Part One

The next 3 days cover

Part Two

The first part of the course covers fire safety management documentation and how to develop fire training packages for the workplace. It includes:

- Fire records

- Fire warden management
- Training presentations
- Fire awareness and induction

The last 2 days provide an understanding of fire engineering solutions covering:

- Fire inspections
- Arson problems in the workplace
- Fixed fire systems
- Evaluating fire engineering solutions
- An overview of BS7974
