

# Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order

*If you do not meet the requirements of the RR(FS)O, fire authorities can issue formal notices to prevent all or part of your premises being used. Other penalties are a £5,000 fine and 2 years in jail.*

## Who should attend?

Anyone who has control of premises or who has a degree of control over certain areas or systems including:

- Directors or managers of premises that staff may have access to
- Managing agents or owners of shared parts of premises or shared fire safety equipment
- Occupiers of premises if they have any control
- Any person who has some control over part of a premises
